Institute Diploma Programs

This packet contains current information regarding the calendar, admissions, diploma requirements, regulations, and course offerings. Hope Baptist Institute reserves the right to withdraw a course, change tuition, and other fees, change the calendar and rules regarding admission, and graduation requirements, and change any other regulations affecting the student body. Enrollment in Hope Baptist Institute is a privilege and not a right. Students forfeit this privilege if they do not conform to the standards and ideals of work and life at the Institute and the Institute may insist on the withdrawal of a student at any time that the student does not conform, in the opinion of the Institute, to the spirit of the Institute. Hope Baptist Institute does not hold, nor does it seek to hold, state accreditation of its diploma programs. The Institute is a ministry of Hope Baptist Church, North Little Rock-Sherwood, AR, an autonomous, local Baptist Church and, as such does not desire, seek, nor accept state approval. The Institute does not seek any other secular recognition of its programs of instruction. No student or graduate should consider his diploma as qualifying him to hold a secular position of employment. The diplomas and certificates awarded signify fulfillment of the prescribed courses of study specifically designed to prepare servants of God for the Christian ministry in local Baptist churches. If a student desires to transfer to another institution, it is the responsibility of the student to determine if the credits earned at Hope Bible Institute will be transferable. Each institution of higher learning sets its own standards and accepts credits according to the merits of the individual. Hope Baptist Institute makes no guarantee that any course will transfer to any other institution. However, several Bible colleges and Institutes will accept transfer credit from Hope Baptist Institute. Of course, the desire of Hope Baptist Institute is that students will complete the course of study they initially pursue. Currently, the Institute offers a Bible Institute Diploma after completing 32 hours of classes, a two year Bible Institute Diploma after 64 hours of credit, and a Graduate of Theology Diploma after completing 96 hours of classes. A student may receive a Bachelor of Bible Diploma after 128 hours of study.
